

# Song – We are going to the Mountains

**Target Language: -ing and Prepositions**

## WHAT YOU DO

1. If there is space, get all the children to stand in a circle.
2. Get the children to mime each of the actions as they sing the song (e.g. when singing, 'going to the mountains', they could mime walking or the action of a train).
3. After singing the basic version of the song, in groups (or one group if the class is small) the children work out a sequence of events for a typical day in their lives, a special day out, an imaginary trip, etc. They can draw these events on pieces of paper, and then sing them with appropriate mimes.

## FOLLOW-UP

The children can work out a new song from a cartoon strip or other picture sequences. They then sing and mime it, either taking the roles of the characters in the pictures or using the structures, 'They are...../She is.....'.
