Quiet flows creativity of children

Tiny tots come up with interesting displays on water

PUDUCHERRY: Exhibiting water in all its forms, tiny tots of Lycee Francais's pre-elementary school came up with an interesting collection drawings, paintings, models and even stories at an exhibition on Thursday.

The exhibition, "Water in all its forms," was an outcome of three months of research, studies and scientific activities on the theme of water. The Kindergarten - pre-elementary school of Lycee Francais has 108 children in the age group of 2 to 6 years, said Brigitte Maury, Project Manager at Lycee Francais.

Filled with enthusiasm, the little ones had come up with different kinds of experiments with water such as story of rain, formation of water, mixing water with colours, different uses of water and forms of water. The children had put up pictures on the different uses of water such as for drinking, bathing, washing clothes and watering plants. In addition to this,

pictures on different forms of water such as ice berg, rain, sea, river, water falls, glacier and oasis were part of the exhibition.

"The exhibition is an expression of the children's colourful life through drawings, pictures, tales and documentation. This event is one of the many educational creative projects carried out by the kindergarten students of Lycee Francais. Every three months, the school organises a presentation of the children's works which are based on a particular theme. There are three levels of classes at the school," she added.

A student had depicted the journey of little drop of water through a drawing in a story format, while models of water mixed with flour with interesting shapes and decorations were created by the young ones.

Interestingly, the kindergarten kids had also depicted through photographs how water was used in preparing lemonade.
