

GROUP #1 : FRONTPAGE OF THE *OMAHA BEE*, Tuesday 6th January 1891

General task :

You are a member of the editorial board of the *Omaha Bee*. Your newspaper has sent a reporter to the scene of the battle to gather first-hand accounts from the soldiers and attend the burial of the dead. You have to prepare the front page for Tuesday 6 January 1891 devoted to the battle. The front page presents the background to the event, how the battle unfolded and its immediate consequences (casualties).

Founded in 1871, the *Omaha Bee* was a republican newspaper. At the time, it was Nebraska's leading daily newspaper. It ceased publication in 1922.

Task layout :

- You will work in teams. You will need to divide the work between you to be efficient
- To help you in your research, you will be provided with web resources
- You will choose on the following websites a template to lay out your front page:
