The 9/11 Memorial & Museum are located at the World Trade Center. We strongly recommend the use of public transportation.

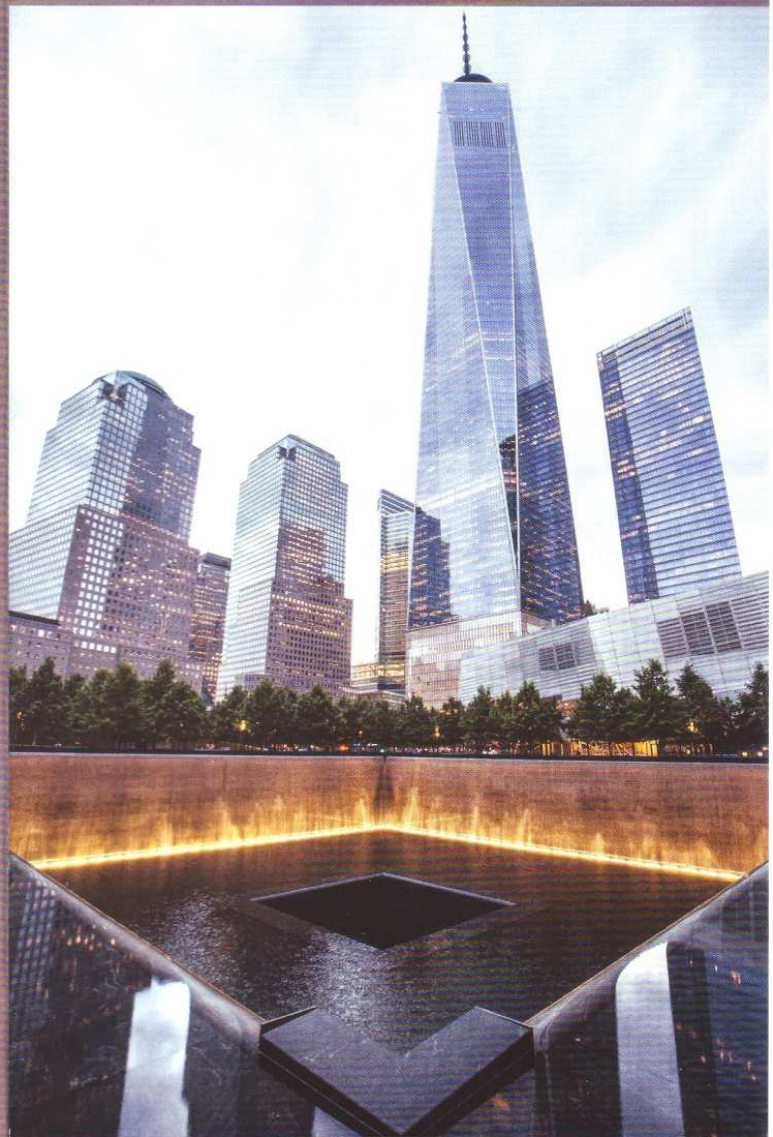
By Subway:

- A C J Z 2 3 4** or **5** trains to Fulton Street
- 2** or **3** trains to Park Place
- E** train to World Trade Center
- R** train to Rector Street or Cortlandt Street
- 1** train to Rector Street

THE NATIONAL SEPTEMBER 11 MEMORIAL & MUSEUM honors the 2,983 people who were killed in the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001 and February 26, 1993. The 9/11 Memorial is a place of remembrance that commemorates those who were killed, honors those who risked their lives to save others and reflects on the courage and compassion shown in the aftermath. The 9/11 Memorial Museum is the global focal point for preserving the history of the events of September 11, documenting the impact of 9/11 and exploring the continued significance of the attacks through monumental and personal artifacts, first-person accounts and multimedia displays.

GUIDED MUSEUM TOURS



Join a guide on a 60-minute tour of the Museum, examining authentic artifacts to understand what happened on 9/11, how people responded in the aftermath of the attacks, and the history and rebuilding of the World Trade Center. Tours are oriented for adult and teenage visitors.
