What are the main objectives of plant maintenance?


The main goal of plant maintenance is to ensure the conditions in which a plant can reach peak productivity while keeping the maintenance costs as low as possible:


Things you can do on the plant floor

If your facility is not under complete lockdown, there are plenty of things you can do to improve plant maintenance while the production lines are not running:




Things you can do from home
