Bath City Boat Trip & Walking Tour



Get a unique perspective of this World Heritage city from the river and on foot.

This 80-minute small-group tour combines a boat trip with a walking tour of central Bath and will give you an overview of the city's rich history and attractions.

The savvy guides will not leave you in the past, so you can make the most of your visit.

Ideal for visitors who want to maximise their time in Bath and families with Children.

Start with a river cruise along the River Avon, taking in sights such as Half Penny Bridge, St. John's Church, Bath Abbey, Parade Gardens, Pulteney Bridge, the Weir and the Mill.

Once back at the mooring, a guide will take you on a short 50-minute walking tour, designed to give you a taste of Bath's history and orientate you with the city.

The tour includes the popular sights of the Roman Baths, The Abbey, Guildhall, the Ancient City Wall, the Theatre Royal, and Queens Square.

The total combined tour is approximately 80 minutes in duration and will provide plenty of signposting to allow you to explore the city on your own and make the most effective use of your time.

Being just 80 minutes in total it is ideal for families with children and there is a kid's quiz to help keep them interested on the walking tour.
